ABOUT PENFIELD

Penfield was founded in 1979 by Joan Liffing-Zug Bourret, an Iowa photographer and writer, and her late husband, John Zug, an editor and writer. The company is named in honor of the publisher's grandmother, Eva Adora Penfield, daughter of a Civil War veteran and his wife who flipped a coin and decided to join the last covered wagon train west from Wichita, Kansas, to Bellingham, Washington, in the 1870s. Over 30 years and more than 110 titles later, Penfield now has sales throughout the United States and in Canada, Europe, Australia, and New Zealand. In 2001, we founded a sister company called Penfield Books. Penfield Books publishes and distributes existing Penfield Press titles, as well as new titles with the Penfield Books imprint.

Penfield has brought back into print selective writings of Selma Lagerlöf, who, in 1909, became the first female writer (and the first Swede) to win the Nobel Prize in literature. Difficult to find in translation, her writings had been out of print for more than 60 years. She is noted for *Gösta Berling's Saga*, *Memories of Märbacka*, and her wonderful children's book *The Wonderful Adventures of Nils and the Further Adventures of Nils Holgersson*.

We have published the translation of both Nils books in one. Nils is a little boy, miniaturized, who flies all over Sweden on the back of a goose with a flock. He learns to be kind to animals. There is also ecological wisdom applicable to today in this book. Penfield takes great pride in publishing these works by one of Sweden's best-loved storytellers.

In 2009, we were recognized by a Midwest Independent Publishers Association (MIPA) 2008 prize winner for our title, *License to Cook Missouri Style*. The 19th Annual Midwest book awards attracted 149 nominations from 66 publishers in the 12 Midwestern states in our region. In 2008, Penfield was recognized as a MIPA 2007 prize winner for our title, *Recetas De Vieho Mexico: Recipes of Old Mexico*. These titles are included in our popular 3-1/2 x 5-1/2" Stocking Stuffer series. These books range in price from \$6.95 to \$7.95. We also stock larger 6 x 9" titles each about Norway, Sweden, Denmark, and Finland. Our Scandinavian larger titles are updated often.

Among Penfield's authors, Julie Jensen McDonald, Pat Martin, Louise Roalson, and Carol Van Klompenburg have all won top national honors in the National Federation of Press Women contests, for books published by Penfield. David and Jeanne Wright of Decorah are among our editors who check information for accuracy as do Dorothy Crum, Melinda Bradnan and Connie Schnoebelen. Deb Schense, our primary editorial associate, authored a book *Eastern Iowa's Historic Barns* and was instrumental in the creation of *Barns Around Iowa* by Luella Hazeltine.

Penfield's ethnic books are of primary interest to Americans of Czech, Danish, Dutch, Finnish, French, German, Icelandic, Irish, Norwegian, Polish, Scottish, Slovak, Swedish, and Ukrainian descent. Several new titles are released each year. In 2010, Penfield will release a revised *Recipes from Ireland*, expanded by 50 new pages including interesting Ireland facts. Sally Hubiak, who has Baba's Place in Connecticut, is compiling a little Stocking Stuffer cookbook, *Hungarian Recipes*. This is her heritage, and she makes frequent trips to Hungary.

Penfield is dedicated to quality, accuracy, in the production of books that are both treasured and useful.

Three thousand eight hundred and six middle-aged men with high cholesterol levels participated in the study following a controlled diet. One of the findings was that for each 1 percent fall in cholesterol, a 2 percent reduction in heart attack risk can be expected.

The recipes in this book are designed for a prudent diet, not a radical one, to lower blood cholesterol levels. They are moderately low in cholesterol and fat. These recipes do not address special diets such as low sodium.

Each recipe specifies the number and size of servings. Amounts of meat, dairy products, eggs, margarine, and oil provided in each serving are indicated below most recipes. A guide is suggested for conversions if you wish to estimate cholesterol content of a serving.

Coronary artery disease remains one of the leading causes of death and disability in the United States. A healthy diet is still one of the best measures for prevention.

The recipes from this book are compiled by Joanne Asala. She is the author and editor of nineteen books on folk tales and traditional customs, including *Whistling Jigs to the Moon: Tales of Irish and Scottish Pipers* and *Legends of Irish Saints and Sinners*.

Born and raised in Chicago, home to one of the country's largest Irish-American populations, Joanne's love of Celtic lore has taken her on numerous trips to the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland, where many of the recipes in this book were gathered from people who still cook in the same manner as their ancestors.

Originally 120 pages, we have added about 50 more pages about the Irish, their traditions, their important sites and their famous authors compiled by David Wright. Formerly with the Morgan Library in New York City, he is an excellent writer and scholar. Today he is associated with the Norwegian Genealogy Center in Madison, Wisconsin.

The front cover photograph and the back cover is from a painting by Patrick Costello whose ancestors fled the potato famine in Ireland.

Recipes

Scones (*Recipes From Ireland*)

2 cups self-rising flour
3 tablespoons butter
Pinch of salt
1/2 cup whole milk (not skim)

Sift flour into bowl and "pinch" in the butter with your fingertips. Add the salt and mix in the milk a little at a time. Knead lightly to form a soft dough, adding more liquid if necessary. Roll out 1/2-inch thick. Cut into scones with a round cutter, but do not twist or they will distort while baking. You can also cut into 2-inch squares. Place on greased cookie sheet near the top of a 425° oven; bake for 12 to 15 minutes. Makes eight. **Variation:** For sweet scones add 2 tablespoons sugar and 1 tablespoon caraway seeds.

Ham and Pea Soup (*Recipes From Ireland*)

2 large onions, sliced
2 tablespoons bacon drippings
1 ham bone and trimmings
1 pound dried peas, soaked
1 bay leaf
Chopped fresh mint or parsley
Fresh herbs to taste
7 to 10 cups ham water or broth
Salt and pepper to taste
Chopped fresh mint or parsley

In a large saucepan, sauté the onions in the bacon drippings. Add the ham bone, peas, bay leaf, and herbs. Cover with the broth or ham water. Bring to a boil; simmer for 2 hours. Remove the bone. Dice any ham or bacon trimmings which can go back into the soup. Discard bay leaf. Milk or water may be added to thin soup. Season and serve with parsley or mint.

Banana Bread (*Microwave Recipes*)

3 ripe bananas, mashed
1 1/2 cups flour
2/3 cup sugar
1/2 cup melted butter
2 eggs
1/2 cup sour cream
1 teaspoon baking soda

Topping:

1/2 cup flour
1/4 cup dark brown sugar
2 tablespoons butter or margarine

In a large mixing bowl, beat together all bread ingredients. Grease a 10-cup glass or plastic tube pan. Pour batter into pan and sprinkle with topping. Microwave on medium power for 8 to 10 minutes, or until loaf tests done. **Topping:** Blend together all ingredients. Sprinkle over uncooked batter.

Slovak Haluski (*Side Dish*) (*Slovak Recipes*)

2 medium-size potatoes, peeled
2 eggs, beaten
Dash pepper
1/2 teaspoon salt
2 cups white flour
1 (3-ounce) package of cream cheese (room temperature)
1 small carton small curd cottage cheese

8 to 10 slices bacon, diced and fried
2 quarts water, lightly salted

Grate potatoes into large mixing bowl. Do not drain liquid. Add eggs, salt and pepper. Stir together until well mixed. Add flour and mix well. Drop by half teaspoonfuls into lightly boiling water. Boil for 10 minutes and drain. While *haluski* are cooking, mix cream cheese and cottage cheese together, blending well. Brown diced bacon in skillet and drain. Set bacon aside on absorbant paper. Brown butter in same pan. Remove pan from heat and add hot *haluski*, bacon, cheeses altogether and stir well. Serves 4.

Corn Casserole (*Healthy Recipes*)

1 (16-ounce) can whole kernel corn
2 eggs
2 tablespoons flour
2 tablespoons sugar
2 tablespoons melted margarine
1 cup grated Cheddar cheese, divided

Combine corn, eggs, flour, sugar, margarine, and 1/4 cup cheese in a 1-1/2-quart casserole. Cover and bake at 375 degrees for 40 minutes; then sprinkle on remaining cheese, and bake uncovered at 350 degrees for 15 minutes. Yield: 6 servings (1/2 cup each). 1 serving = 1 teaspoon margarine, 2/3 dairy equivalent, and 1/3 egg.

Sour Cream-Apple Cake (*Buffets & Potlucks*)

1 cup butter	1/2 teaspoon salt
1-1/4 cups sugar	1-1/2 teaspoons apple pie spice
1 tablespoon grated orange rind	1 cup sour cream
3 eggs	1 cup chopped tart apples
2-1/2 cups flour	1 cup raisins
1 teaspoon baking powder	1 cup chopped nuts
1 teaspoon baking soda	

Cream butter, sugar and orange rind until fluffy. Beat in eggs. Combine dry ingredients in one bowl and sour cream and apples in another. Add each mixture alternately to the creamed mixture. Stir in raisins and nuts. Turn batter into greased and floured 10-inch tube pan, and bake at 350 degrees for 55 to 60 minutes, or until cake tests done. Cool cake in pan for about 10 minutes before turning out on rack to complete cooling. If desired, dust with powdered sugar at serving time or serve slices with whipped cream.

In the case of May, a 2-year-old Labradoodle, you interview other dogs, find out that they—unlike you—all get to bed down with their masters and then you write a book about your quest. And you keep hoping your owners will relent, move over and make room for you to crawl onto the bed.

Finding My Way is a whimsical smile-inducing autobiography written by May McGregor Bourret, as told to her owners, Dwayne and Joan Liffing-Zug Bourret of Iowa City and McGregor.

In the book, May details her early training and her masters' attempts to make her less submissive. Meeting a stranger, she drops and rolls over to show she's no threat. She works on her self-image.

Like any youngster, she considers boyfriends and various careers. Her long legs and sleek hair seem to qualify her for being a model. So she poses for Joan Liffing-Zug Bourret—a well known photographer—in a variety of hats, wigs, outfits and jewels. The resulting color photographs are numerous and charming.

Though modeling is fun, May discovers a job custom-made for a friendly dog when the Rev. Laura Gentry of McGregor teaches her the art of yoga laughter. Gentry provides laughter exercises for canine and human, with enough dog treat recipes thrown in to make any pooch sit up and beg.

The best part of the book, though, is the interview with prominent Eastern Iowans and their dogs on their sleeping arrangements. The best line comes from the owner of two very large Weimaraners: "My sleep-

Weston Naef, then assistant curator of photography at the Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York, selected two of these images, Nan Wood Graham, Model for American Gothic, 1975, and Junior League Christmas Party, 1962, for the museum's photography collection. (See the webstore.)

Many of the images have gentle satire such as the Coe College Faculty Wives' Club disapproving members with a painting of a semi-nude by Kuniyoshi. Two of the photographs, The Junior League Christmas Party and Nan Wood Graham, are in the collection of the Metropolitan Museum of Art. The Nan Wood Graham photograph is also in the book, *Grant Wood and Little Sister Nan* (\$16.95) and in *My Brother Grant Wood* (\$16.95) by Nan Wood Graham. Both prints are available in an edition of not more than 50 copies.

This series of photographs now hang permanently at Kirkwood Community College, Cedar Rapids, Iowa. The book begins with a photograph of the Iowa Officers of the Women's Christian Temperance Union, Washington, Iowa 1967. Joan has been a photographer for over 60 years.

The photographer says, "During the years that I took these photographs, I did not realize how they documented the limited roles of women in that era. I wanted to explore their lives to see why my own life seemed so alienated and different from theirs in so many instances. With the birth of the women's movement in the 1960s, these photographs ultimately defined some of the social conditions of this era."
